ISDC funding

Funding of the swiss confederation is approved until end of 2011
(2MCHF/yr).

Two additional (i.e. 4 in total) positions to be funded by the University of Geneva.

Time correlation problems are converging


Delay between observation and distribution: 1 month

44 ATELs (7 per month)



Operations: good time

Operations: time correlation


delta2 = duration of 1800s OBT, corrected for thermal effects on oscillator frequency

“Removing” outliers: $1 \sigma = 29 \mu\text{sec}$


Operations: distribution delay

Delay between observation and distribution




Operations: archive usage (not incl. IT, ISOC, ...)

Release: on September 26, 2007


Downloads on June 9 (8.5 months): 154

OSA 6.0 downloads over 9 months: 122


OSA 5.1 downloads over 13 months: 180
