- Celia Sanchez now main responsible for Long-Term Plan.



- New Archive infrastructure coming together. Roadmap defined. Disks now maintained by Science Archive Team. Direct interface ISDC/SAT being set up for further data ingestion.
- A literature survey is ongoing to link observations and refereed papers. Historical publications mainly done.
- Significant effort invested into support for Earth/CXB observations. Increased effort also for coordinated observations.
- AO-11 preparations going routinely. No major changes expected.
- TOO response unchanged – mainly limited by technical constraints. Last TOO on Swift J174510.8-262411 was done in 8.5 h from alert.
